

## LAOS: Sample Itinerary

All itineraries can be altered in length, focus and style to fit school requirements.



DAY	DATE	ACTIVITY	DESCRIPTION
1		Depart Australia	Depart Australia.
2		Arrive Laos	Arrive in Luang Prabang. The team need to arrange their accommodation in Luang Prabang. The team has the afternoon and evening to explore the town, possibly including a visit to one of the famous Wat's in town or a climb up Mount Phu Si to see sunset over Luang Prabang.
3		Seuang River Village	This morning you will depart early and drive through the remote areas around Luang Prabang and arrive in the Seuang river valley in time for lunch. Meet your hosts and spend the afternoon trying your hand at some local bamboo rafting or visiting a local school
4		Community Project	Group to receive an orientation to the community project and begin working on a project to provide better facilities for the local high school students.
5		Community Project	Continue working on the project, whilst at the project all meals will be provided by your hosts.
6		Community Project	The team can get involved with teaching and games with the local students.
7		Community Project	Continue working on the project, whilst at the project the group will stay in tradition, local accommodation in the village.
8		Community Project	Spend a final day working on the community project. Tonight join in a small celebration to say farewell to your hosts.
9		Trek	Trek through the remote hilltribes amongst H'mong and Khamu villages, the groups will be staying in traditional long houses on the trek.
10		Trek	Continue trek, whilst on the trek the group will have all meals provided by the local in country agent.
11		Trek	Continue trek, whilst on the trek the group will have all meals provided by the local in country agent.
12		Trek	Final day of trek
13		Vieng Kham	This morning you will be met and driven through the Seuang River valley and arrive in Vieng Kham late afternoon. Group to arrange accommodation on arrival.
14		Muong Ngoi	Group to arrange transport to to Moug Ngoi. Group has the afternoon to explore the countryside around Muong Ngoi. Group needs to organise accommodation on arrival.
15		Boat to Nong Khiaw	Group to arrange a slow boat down the Nam Ou river from Muong Ngoi to Nong Khiaw through stunning limestone karst mountains and past traditional Laotian villages. This is a great river trip and would be a good option if the team fly directly into Luang Prabang instead of coming in on the river from Thailand.
16		To Luang Prabang	Continue boating down the Nam Ou River to Luang Prabang. Arrive in Luang Prabang in time for sunset and the lovely Luang Prabang night market. Accommodation to be organised by group.
17		Luang Prabang	Group has the day to explore Luang Prabang, possibly including a visit to the beautiful Kuang Si waterfall or organising an elephant ride outside of town
18		Luang Prabang	Awake early to watch the procession of monks at sunrise, a sight to behold. Group to arrange transport to visit the sights of Laos.
19		Travel South	The group has options to explore the incredible temples, markets, waterfalls, dolphins, elephant sanctuaries, tribal villages of Laos. Vang Vieng and Vietiane are options.
20		Travel South	If the team decides to go further south and miss the Nam Ou River slow boat, they can travel overland for a couple of days visiting the rice paddies and coffee plantations of the south, with excellent options of Angkor Temples, Mekong dolphins, waterfalls, islands and sleepy villages.
21		Return Australia	Return to Australia.
