UniBreak Group Placements

Group placements allow students and staff (if required) to travel overseas and apply their course work in new and sometimes challenging settings. In turn, students gain highly valuable international experience and perspective allowing them to grow on both a personal and professional level. At the same time, group placements allow universities to raise their profile both locally and internationally and strengthen bonds between the university, students and staff members.

Education Placement Cambodia

The education placement in Cambodia gives students an exciting opportunity to gain invaluable personal and professional experience in a cross-cultural setting and a chance to use their skills and knowledge to contribute to a developing community.



Placements are available in Siem Reap working with a range of local non- governmental organisations. The organisations hold free classes for primary school children all day long. These classes provide the children with an opportunity to learn English and are an important step in reintegrated disadvantaged or orphaned children into the public school system. Teaching follows a flexible syllabus based on the Lets Go series and involves conversation exercises, games and songs. Students generally teach for two to three hours a day and also spend time planning lessons and arranging teaching aids and resources. Class sizes can range from 10 to 20 students and students are generally between 4 and 17 years of age. Students teach from Monday to Friday with Saturday and Sunday off.



Accommodation

Teams stay in local guesthouse accommodation on a twin-share basis with breakfast and dinner included. Lunch will be served at respective schools.

Weekends and Free time

Siem Reap is an exciting place to be in evenings or on weekends with its many bars, cafes, museums and art galleries. There are many places to visit whilst in Cambodia from the hip and happening cultural city of Phnom Penh to the beaches in Sihanoukville or of course the Angkor temples in Siem Reap.

SAMPLE ITINERARY



Day 1

Today you will travel via Bangkok to Siem Reap, home of the spectacular Angkor Wat temple complex. Arrive in Siem Reap and be transported to your simple but comfortable guesthouse which will be home for the rest of your stay in Cambodia.

Accommodation – Guesthouse accommodation in Siem Reap.

Meals – Breakfast + Dinner

Day 2 -3

Spend the next few days with our in-country agent taking part in an orientation on Cambodian culture, cuisine and language to fully prepare you for your volunteer placement. Explore the area and savour local specialties at inexpensive restaurants for your lunch and dinner during your placement.

Accommodation – Guesthouse accommodation Siem Reap.

Meals – Breakfast + Dinner

Day 4 onwards

Work 5 days per week in small groups assisting and observing local staff at an educational centre for English and vocational training at a childrens' home supporting disadvantaged youth and young adults. You may also be part of teacher training workshops at the organisation. Help implement community and educational programs with the assistance of our in-country agent.

Accommodation – Guesthouse accommodation Siem Reap.

Meals – Breakfast + Dinner

Weekends

Explore Cambodia on your weekends and immerse yourself in the colourful culture and gentle lifestyle of this beautiful country. Visit the Mekong river which flows through Phnom Penh and the Gulf of Thailand which lies to the south. Relax on some of the region's most beautiful beaches.

Last day

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast and transfer to the airport for your flight home.
